All applicants must be full time students (3 or more classes) currently enrolled in a Canadian high school or post-secondary institution who are preparing to apply for a Canadian university or college program starting in September 2016 - and who are being or have been treated by a clinician for an eating disorder.

Young people recovering from an eating disorder demonstrate impressive courage and strength as they face down the very real challenges of this disease. The Looking Glass Foundation **Scholarship** program supports that recovery effort by helping them find a fresh start in life through education.

Applicants from anywhere in BC are invited to apply.

Applications for the 2017 **SCHOLARSHIP** program open March 15th. Deadline for submissions is **July 4th.** Recipients will be announced and notified by phone on **July 14th**, with cheques issued by **July 21st.**

Applicants are invited to complete **One** Application Form, answer a (maximum) 500-word essay question, and provide a letter of recommendation, verification of student enrollment, and verification of clinical treatment.
